Cycle 1 of CPR (30:2)	Adult Compressions – Performs high-quality compressions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Hand placement of lower half of sternum ➤ 30 compressions in >=15 seconds and <=18 seconds ➤ Compresses at least 2 inches ➤ Complete recoil after each compression 	
	Adult Breaths – Gives 2 breaths with a barrier device: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Each breath given over 1 second ➤ Visible chest rise with each breath ➤ Resumes compressions in less than 10 seconds 	
Cycle 2 of CPR	Compressions (Only check box if step is successfully performed)	
	Breaths (Only check box if step is successfully performed)	
	Resumes compressions in less than 10 seconds	
Rescuer 2 says "Here is the AED. I'll take over compressions and you use the AED."		
AED (follows prompts of)	Powers on AED	
	Correctly attaches pads	
	Clears for analysis	
	Clears to safely deliver a shock	
	Safely delivers a shock	
Resumes CPR	Ensures compressions are resumed immediately after shock delivery

Cycle 1 of CPR (30:2)	Infant Compressions – Performs high-quality compressions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 2 fingers in the center of the chest, just below nipple line ➤ 30 compressions in >=15 seconds and <=18 seconds ➤ Compresses at least 1/3 depth of chest, about 1 ½ inches ➤ Complete recoil after each compression 	
	Infant Breaths – Gives 2 breaths with a barrier device: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Each breath given over 1 second ➤ Visible chest rise with each breath ➤ Resumes compressions in less than 10 seconds 	
Cycle 2 of CPR	Compressions (Only check box if step is successfully performed)	
	Breaths (Only check box if step is successfully performed)	
	Resumes compressions in less than 10 seconds	
Rescuer 2 arrives with a bag-mask device and begins ventilation while Rescuer 1 continues compressions with 2 thumb encircling-hands technique		
Cycle 3 of CPR Rescuer 1	Infant Compressions – Performs high-quality compressions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 15 compressions with 2 thumb-encircling hands technique ➤ 15 compressions in >=7 seconds and <=9 seconds ➤ Compresses at least 1/3 depth of chest, about 1 ½ inches ➤ Complete recoil after each compression 	
	Infant Breaths – Gives 2 breaths with a bag-mask device: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Each breath given over 1 second ➤ Visible chest rise with each breath ➤ Resumes compressions in less than 10 seconds 	
Cycle 4 of CPR Rescuer 1	Infant Compressions – Performs high-quality compressions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 15 compressions with 2 thumb-encircling hands technique ➤ 15 compressions in >=7 seconds and <=9 seconds ➤ Compresses at least 1/3 depth of chest, about 1 ½ inches ➤ Complete recoil after each compression 	
	Infant Breaths – Gives 2 breaths with a bag-mask device: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Each breath given over 1 second ➤ Visible chest rise with each breath ➤ Resumes compressions in less than 10 seconds
